This Community Benefit funded program engages interns in meaningful work academic major and exposes them to careers in the health care industry. Over the course of 2-3 summers, interns work on impactful projects contributing to their success and to the success of Kaiser Permanente through professional networking, developing social and technical skills, and collaborating across functions.
